Quick Guide**

Prevent is the Government's strategy to stop people becoming involved in extremism or supporting terrorism, in all forms. Prevent uses early engagement to encourage individuals and communities to challenge violent extremist ideologies and behaviours.

Channel is an early intervention multi agency process designed to safeguard vulnerable people from being drawn into violent extremist or terrorist behaviour. Channel works in a similar way to existing safeguarding hubs. Channel interventions are delivered through local partners and specialist agencies including mentoring, faith guidance and diversionary activities such as sport.

Referrals

- Anyone can refer including Education, Health and Social Services
- Referrals are first screened for suitability through a preliminary assessment by the Channel Coordinator and the Local Authority.

Support

- Will be allocated if the Channel Panel agree
- A person will always be informed if it is felt they would benefit from support

Record

- What the child, young person, vulnerable adult said – using their own words
- Note the context, time and date on your record and sign it
- Avoid judgements and opinions

Raising a concern

If you believe that someone is susceptible to extremism and vulnerable to exploitation or radicalisation, use the established safeguarding procedures to escalate your concerns to the Safeguarding lead who will refer to Channel if appropriate
